TASTING NOTES

THE WINE ADVOCATE – ROBERT PARKER

This wine is not marked Riserva; however, it is released a year after the Brunello annata. The Franco Pacenti 2016 Brunello di Montalcino Rosildo (with a mere 1,000 bottles made) sees its fruit sourced from the Vigna della Creta parcel with a bigger presence of clay in the soils. This is a lovely expression with a very pure and bright sweetness that comes forth as summer ripe cherry and dark plum. The wine is firm at the back with tight tannic grip and strong acidity. Both these elements, plus the oak influences, will aid the wine as it continues its aging trajectory. (Monica Larner)

JAMES SUCKLING

Plenty of cherry and toffee with hints of cedar. Medium body. Firm and polished tannins, and a fresh and driven finish. Focused and attractive at the end. Drink or hold.

JANCIS ROBINSON

Maturing mid ruby with narrow orange rim. Ripe cherry nose with sweet, spicy oak notes. Supple, focused and ripe and with a long, sweet cherry fragrance on the finish. Elegant rather than powerful and with a layer of fine, long tannins. (WS) Drink 2022 – 2030.

WINESCRITIC – RAFFAELE VECCHIONE

Camaleontico e di natura delicata e suadente, mostra note di cipria, caramello dolce, petali di rosa, pepe rosa, guaranà, tiglio, gelsomino, mandarino verde e vetiver. Corpo pieno, tannini di grana finissima ed un finale solido e centrato che cresce dal centro palato in poi. Piccante e davvero intrigante. Meglio dal 2023.
